#### ITEM NO.7: ANY OTHER ACADEMIC RELATED MATTERS.

**Dr. P.G.Venkatakrishnan, Principal & Chairman** placed before the Academic Council that the 2016 regulations is effected from the academic year 2016 – 2017 and onwards and requested the members for the suggestions / modifications in regulation, curriculum, syllabi and Question paper pattern.

The members of the Academic Council suggested the following:

- Students can take any number of one credit courses with a maximum of one course per semester.
- The marks for continuous assessment for theory, Practical and Project work for UG (FT&PT) may be enhanced to 40 and the end semester examinations may carry 60 marks.
- Payment of fee by student for using scribe may be waived.
- The continuous assessment marks for PG thesis work may be enhanced to 50% and end semester examination may carry 50%.
- Choice in the question paper may be removed.
- The question paper pattern may be the same without any change with only Part A and Part B. Part C need not be included.
- The credits may be revised to 2 credits for the practical courses in B.E. CSE programme for atleast one course per semester by increasing the laboratory hours.
- The theory subject 'Electromagnetic theory' may be renamed as 'Engineering Electromagnetic theory' in B.E. ECE programme. Also the subject 'RFMMS' may be added as an elective.
- In B.E. (FT) programme the subject Algebra, Differential and Integral Calculus may be renamed as Maths I, Differential Equations, Vector Calculus and Complex Variables as

Maths II, Fourier Series and Transforms may be renamed as Maths III. Also in B.E (PT) programme the subject Vector Calculus and Complex Variables may be renamed as Maths I, Fourier Series and Transforms may be renamed as Maths II.

 In M.E. Thermal and M.E. CAD programmes, the subject Applied Mathematics and Statistics is to be moved from Elective to Core.

The Principal & Chairman placed before the Academic Council that the maximum period of 14 semesters for completion of B.E. (FT & PT) degree programme for the students admitted in academic year 2008 – 2009 was over by May 2015. An extension period of 2 semesters was already given for the students of that batch as per the recommendation of the Academic Council in its second meeting. Inspite, some of the students have not cleared all the subjects. The third Academic Council has recommended an extension period of one more semester to enable the students to complete their degree.

The Principal & Chairman placed before the Academic Council that the maximum period of 14 semesters for completion of B.E. (FT & PT) degree programme for the students admitted in academic year 2009 – 2010 was over by May 2016. The Academic Council has recommended an extension period of two semesters to enable the students to complete their degree. Also final approval is to be obtained from Anna University, Chennai for the above.

#### ITEM NO.8: CONCLUDING REMARKS BY THE PRINCIPAL & CHAIRMAN.

The Principal & Chairman thanked all the members for their active participation and valuable suggestions on various points discussed in the meeting.
