- \*The Chairman insisted to ensure 5 years of warranty or AMC for newly purchased equipment, so that servicing of equipment can be done
- \*All the department should submit at least one research proposal
- \*Experts may be invited to give special lectures on how to write research proposal under TEOIP-III
- \*It is suggested to offer training on communication skills for first years
- \*Incubation centres may be established in the institution by industries
- \*Collaborative Research can be under taken with industries
- \*Students should be encouraged to do real time projects in industries
- \* Training for industry personal can be offered in recent trends
- \*Hiring of consultancy services can be used for project activities with industries
- \*Awareness should be created among the students to enroll for full time Ph.D.
- \*The chairman insisted to submit the list of faculty members with Ph.D. who haven't obtained guideship along with reasons for not publishing papers in journals
