## The Following Suggestions are given by the members

- In the results analysis, the mechanical second years and third year results were poor and various steps to improve the results must be done through, remedial classes, peer coaching, mentoring and counselling the students.
- 2. Final year students can give awareness about how to apply for IIT Mumbai courses to the Juniors
- 3. Heads of Departments can get the proposals from final year UG students and PG students regarding their projects, evaluate with an internal committee and seed money can be given for the project works.

UG Students maximum amount of Rs. 25,000/-

PG Students maximum amount of Rs. 50,000/-

Initially 30% of the seed money can be given and balance 70% after successful completion. The completed module should be handed over back to the department. (Amount can be given for materials, fabrication testing and characterization)

- Requirement of ST (short term) and LT (long term) goals in alignment with the vision and mission of the department. ST and LT goals should be Quantifiable and Achievable. Teaching Learning State of laboratory, Research leading to IRG to be considered.
- 5. Research Assistantship of Rs. 18,000/- per month can be given from June 2019 onwards.
- 6. Twining activities can be recorded with photos and videos.
- 7. Twinning activity marks is high for Mentor Institution and it should be same for Mentee institution. Why there is a difference in mark was asked by the members. Anyhow twining

activities should be further increased and good mentoring should be given to Government Engineering College, Raipur.

The Principal thanked the chairman and members. The meeting came to an end by 01.30 pm.
