TEQIP grant:

Around Rs.700 lakhs has been allotted by the NPIU, New Delhi under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme - Phase - III. This amount has been used for upgrading the research activities of the institution during the period 2018 - 2020. This grant has various heads such as Procurement of research equipment (Rs.350 lakhs) which comprises of purchase of equipment, furniture, learning resources such as books, e-books and ejournals, minor civil works, Academic activities (Rs.280 lakhs) such as Mentee institution upliftment, conduct of training programmes, attending FDPs, seminars, conferences, incentives for research publications, stipend for research scholars, remuneration for external experts, etc.

AICTE - QIP grant:

The college has been granted financial assistance through this grant. There is one research scholar registered to pursue her PhD degree program under this scheme.
